Business Description and Key Statistics

AEP Plantations PLC, formerly Anglo-Eastern Plantations Plc, is a United Kingdom-based producer of palm oil and rubber with plantations across Indonesia and Malaysia. The Company operates a planted area of approximately 69,100 hectares (ha). The Company operates approximately seven palm oil mills. The Company has its assets based on geographical location, including North Sumatera, Bengkulu, Riau, Bangka, Kalimantan, Plasma and Malaysia. Its fresh fruit bunch (FFB) production in North Sumatera, which aggregates the estates of Musam Utjing, United Kingdom Indonesia Plantation, Simpang Ampat, Tasik Raja, Anak Tasik, Cahaya Pelita Andhika, and Hijau Pryan Perdana produced approximately 397,500 metric tons (mt). Its FFB production in Bengkulu, which aggregates the estates of Puding Mas (MPM) and Alno produced 179,300 mt. Its FFB production in the Riau region, comprising Bina Pitri estates, produced 111,700 mt. Its FFB production in the Bangka region, produced over 18,600 mt.

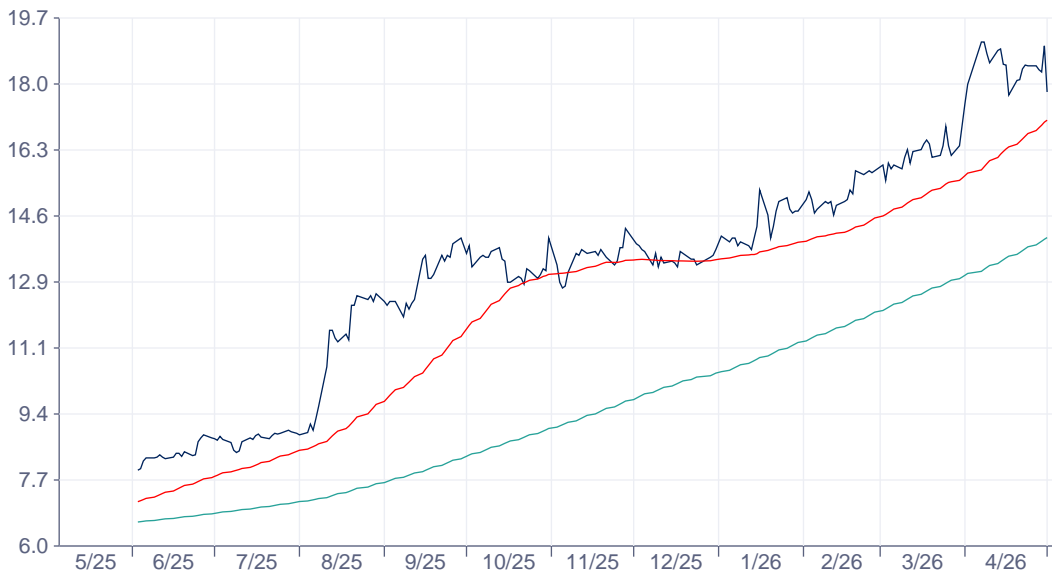

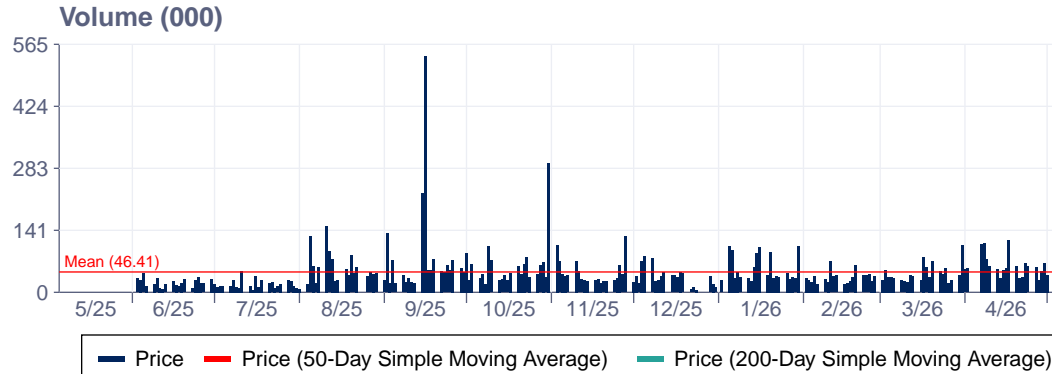
Price, Moving Averages & Volume



AEP Plantations PLC is currently trading at 17.80 which is 4.3% above its 50 day moving average price of 17.07 and 27.1% above its 200 day moving average price of 14.01.

AEP:LN is currently 6.8% below its 52-week high price of 19.10 and is 123.6% above its 52-week low price of 7.96. Over the past 52-weeks, AEP:LN is up 139.9% while on a calendar year-to-date basis it is up 29.9%.

The Relative Strength Index (RSI) indicator for AEP:LN is currently 48.57. An RSI value of 70 and above is considered overbought and 30 and below oversold.

Over the past five years, AEP Plantations PLC's stock price is up 168.1% which is 128.7% above the FTSE 350 Index performance of 39.4% over the same period. AEP Plantations PLC's cumulative annualized growth rate (CAGR) over the five year period has been 21.9% while that of the FTSE 350 Index has been 6.9%.

Over the past year, AEP Plantations PLC's stock price performance of 139.9% has outperformed that of the FTSE 350 Index by 120.4%. On a year-to-date basis, AEP Plantations PLC's stock price performance of 29.9% has outperformed the FTSE 350 Index by 26.0%.

Over the past week, AEP Plantations PLC's stock price performance of -3.7% has underperformed that of the FTSE 350 Index by 3.5%.

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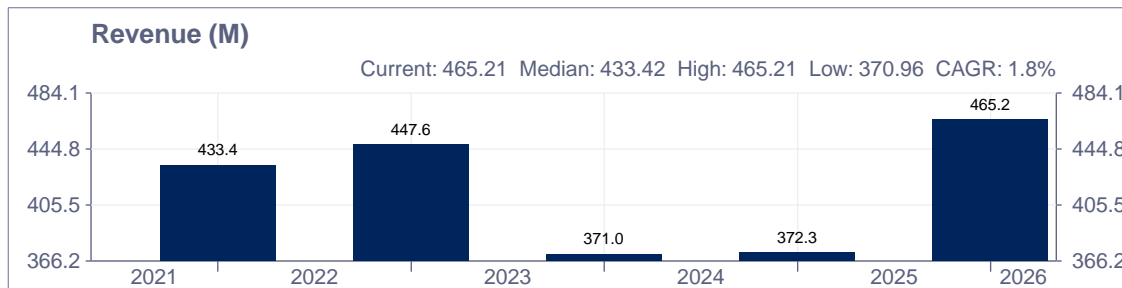
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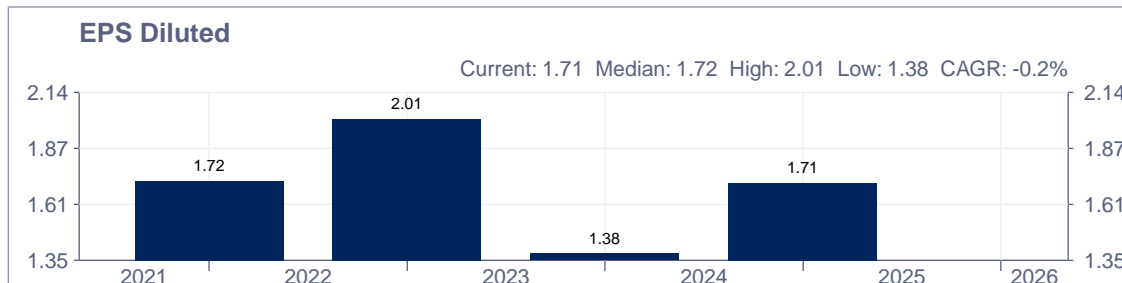

AEP Plantations PLC's cumulative annualized revenue growth rate over the charted period is 1.8%. This compares to cumulative annualized growth of 1.3% over the past 3 years.



AEP Plantations PLC's cumulative annualized EPS growth rate over the charted period is -0.2%. This compares to cumulative annualized growth of -9.4% over the past 3 years.



AEP Plantations PLC's net profit margin of 19.7% is 2.0% above the period's mean net margin of 17.7%. During the charted period, the observed net profit margin high and low were 24.1% and 13.0% respectively.



AEP Plantations PLC's return on equity of 15.7% is 0.5% above the period's mean return on equity of 15.2%. During the charted period, the observed ROE high and low were 25.6% and 10.2% respectively.

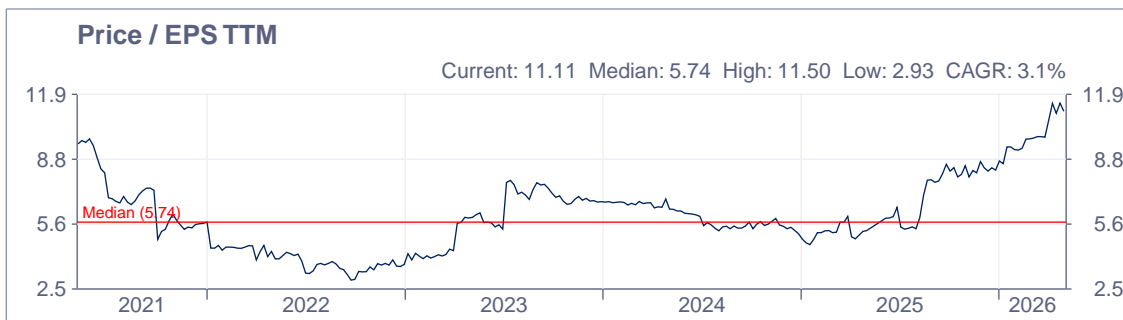

AEP Plantations PLC is trading at 11.11 times its EPS generated during the latest fiscal year. This multiple is above the historically observed median of 5.74, while high and low observations have been 11.50 and 2.93.



AEP Plantations PLC is trading at a Price to Sales ratio of 2.05 based on sales generated during the latest fiscal year. This ratio is above the historically observed median ratio of 0.94, while high and low observations have been 2.12 and 0.71.



AEP Plantations PLC is trading at a Price to Book ratio of 1.64 based on book value at the latest fiscal year end. This ratio is above the historically observed median of 0.80, while high and low observations have been 1.70 and 0.53.



AEP Plantations PLC has a Free Cash Flow Yield of 4.12% based on free cash flow generated during the latest fiscal year. This value is below the historically observed median yield of 7.37%, while high and low observations have been 15.89 and 0.00.

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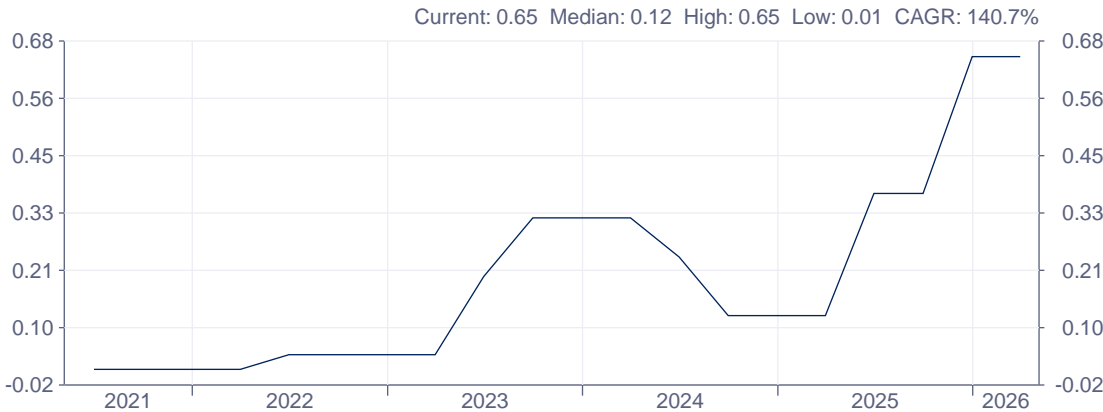

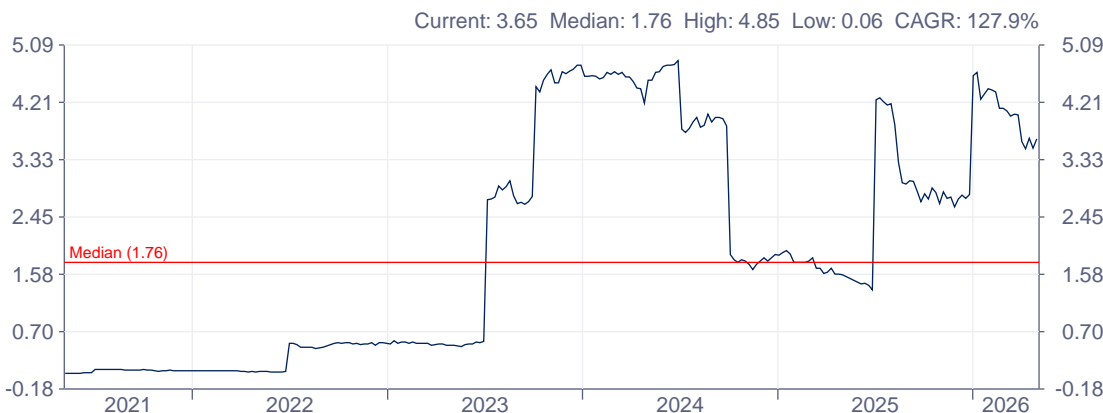
Dividend Growth and Yield

AEP Plantations PLC's trailing 12-month dividend per share is 0.65 and its dividend has grown at a cumulative annualized rate of 140.7% over the charted period. This compares to dividend growth of 447.20% over the past year and cumulative annualized growth of 150.50% over the past 3 years.

AEP Plantations PLC's current dividend yield is 3.65% based on trailing 12 month dividends. The current yield is above the historically observed median of 1.76% and, over the charted time period, the observed high yield has been 4.85% and the observed low yield has been 0.06%.

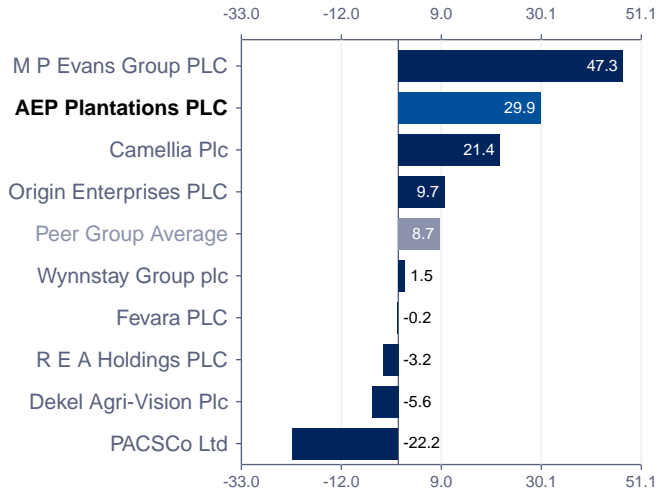
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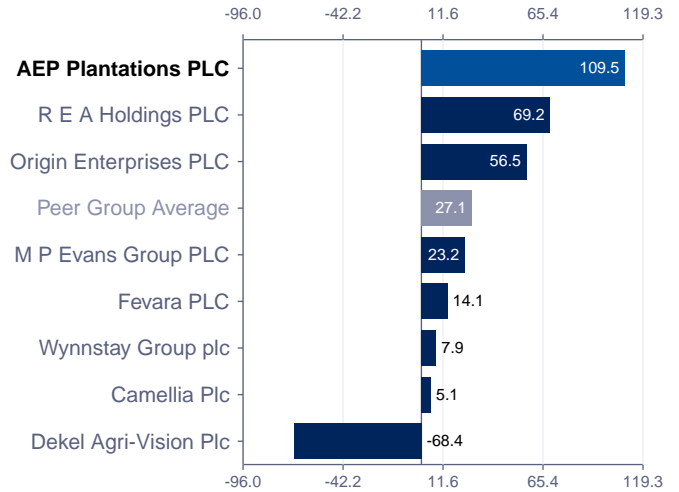

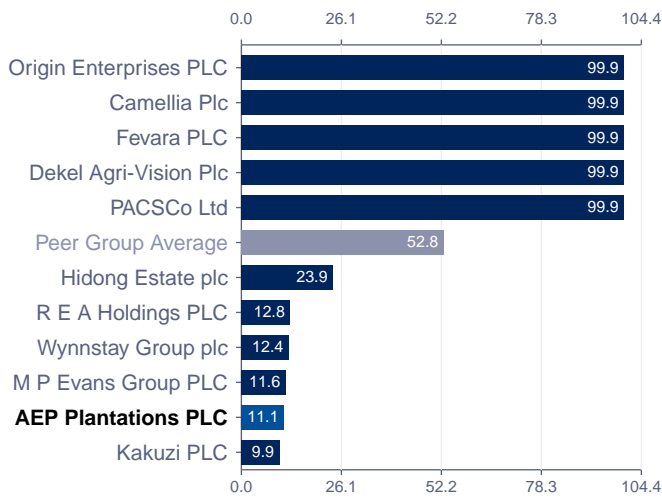
Price Change Year to Date %



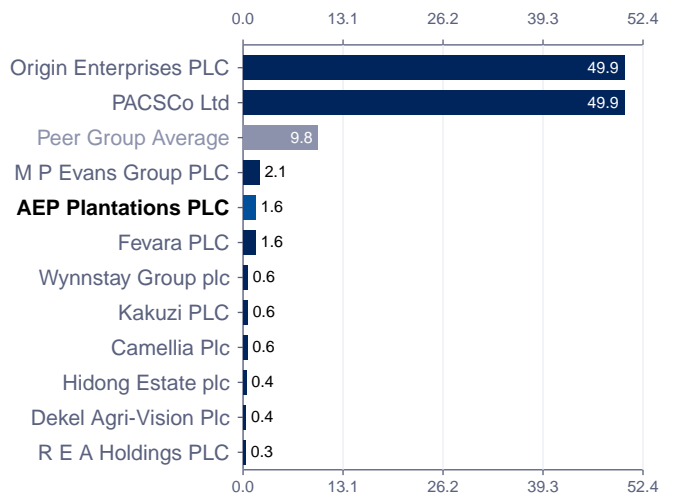
Price Change Last Calendar Year %



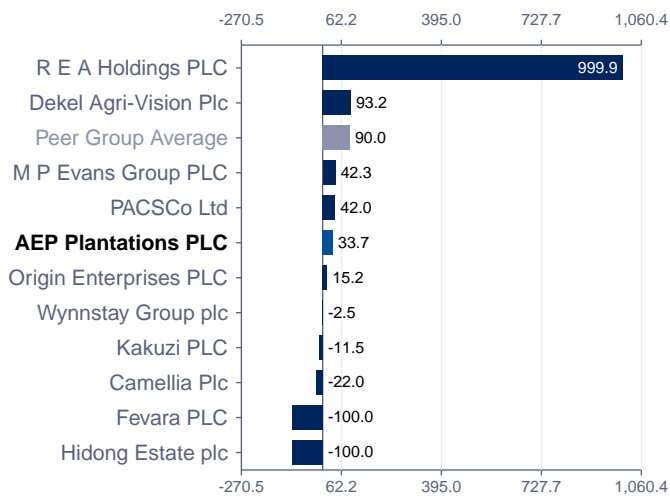
Price / EPS TTM



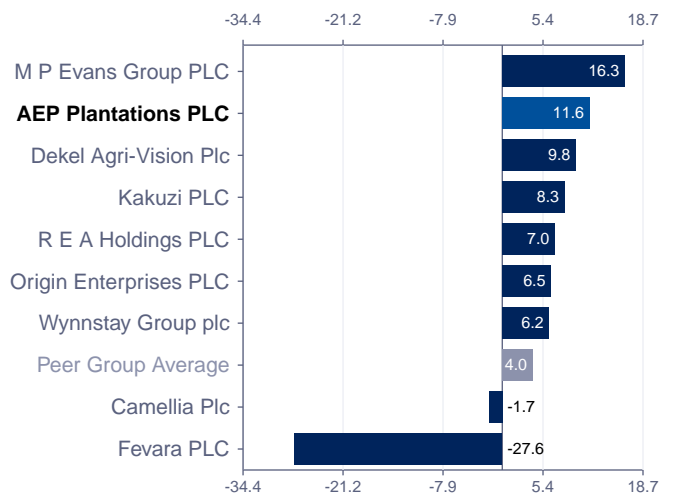
Price / Book Value

Definitions:

Market Value - Weekly Price times latest Shares Outstanding times any applicable ADR factor.

Revenue - Sum of the last four quarters of Revenues.

Revenue Per Share - Sum of the last four quarters of Total Revenue divided by Weighted Average Shares Outstanding.

Normalized EPS LFY - EPS excluding non-recurring, non-operating items, fiscal year aligned TTM value.

60-Day Average Volume (000) - The average of the last 60 daily volume values in thousands of shares.

Price 52-Week High - The high closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price 52-Week Low - The low closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price / 52-Week High - Latest price divided by the high price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price / 52-Week Low - Latest price divided by the low price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

50-Day Average Price - Mean of last 50 daily closing prices.

200-Day Average Price - Mean of last 200 daily closing prices.

Price / 50-Day Average Price - Latest closing price divided by mean of last 50 daily closing prices, as a percentage.

Price / 200-Day Average Price - Latest closing price divided by mean of last 200 daily closing prices, as a percentage.

Relative Strength Index - Relative Strength Index or RSI measures the magnitude of gains over a given time period against the magnitude of losses over that period. The equation is $RSI = 100 - 100 / (1 + RS)$ where $RS = (\text{total gains} / n) / (\text{total losses} / n)$ and $n = \text{number of RSI periods}$. In this item, 14 days is used and one year of daily prices are considered. A value of 30 or below may imply oversold and 70 or above may imply overbought.

Price Volatility - The standard deviation of the last 20 days of daily closing prices.

Sharpe Ratio - The 5 year average of the excess monthly return over the risk - free rate (1 - month T - bill) over the 5 year standard deviation of the same series.

Sortino Ratio - The same calculation as the Sharpe Ratio but with positive excess returns set to zero for the standard deviation denominator, so only negative volatility weighs in.

Dividends Per Share TTM - Sum of the last four quarters of Dividends Per Share.

Payout Ratio - Dividends Per Share TTM divided by Normalized EPS TTM.

Dividend Yield TTM % - Sum of the last four quarter of Dividends Per Share divided by Weekly Price.

EBITDA - Sum of the last four quarters of EBITDA (Operating Income + Depreciation & Amortization).

Free Cash Flow - Sum of the last four quarters Net Cash from Operations minus Capital Expenditures (Purchase of Property, Plant & Equipment), from the Cash Flow Statement.

Book Value Per Share - Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter.

Gross Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters Gross Profit divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

EBITDA Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters EBITDA divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

Pre-Tax Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters of Earnings Before Taxes divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

Net Profit Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues Per Share.

Return on Equity % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Book Value.

Return on Capital % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Capital Per Share.

Return on Assets % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Assets Per Share.

Price / EPS TTM - Weekly Price divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS (capped at 99.9).

Price / Sales - Weekly Price divided by Revenues Per Share TTM.

Price / Book Value - Weekly Price divided by Book Value Per Share last quarter. Book Value Per Share is Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter (capped at 49.9).

Free Cash Flow Yield % - Free Cash Flow Per Share TTM divided by Weekly Price.

Enterprise Value - Market Value plus Total Debt last year plus Preferred Equity last year minus Cash & Cash Equivalents last year.

Enterprise Value / Sales - Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Revenue.

Enterprise Value / EBITDA - Enterprise Value divided by EBITDA TTM.

Enterprise Value / EBIT - Enterprise Value divided by trailing four quarters of Operating Income.

Enterprise Value / Free Cash Flow - Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Free Cash Flow.
