Business Description and Key Statistics

BHP Group Limited is an Australia-based resources company. The Company is a producer of commodities, including iron ore, copper, nickel, potash and metallurgical (steelmaking) coal. It is focused on offering a range of resources, which provides copper for renewable energy; nickel for electric vehicles; potash for sustainable farming, and iron ore and metallurgical coal for the steel needed for global infrastructure and the energy transition. Its segments include Copper, Iron Ore, and Coal. Its Copper segment is engaged in mining of copper, silver, zinc, molybdenum, uranium, and gold. Its Iron Ore segment is engaged in mining of iron ore. Its Coal segment is engaged in mining of metallurgical coal and energy coal. The Company is also focused on operating Olympic Dam, Prominent Hill, and Carrapateena underground copper-gold mines in South Australia. Its operations are situated in Australia, Europe, China, Japan, India, South Korea, rest of Asia, North America, South America, and others.

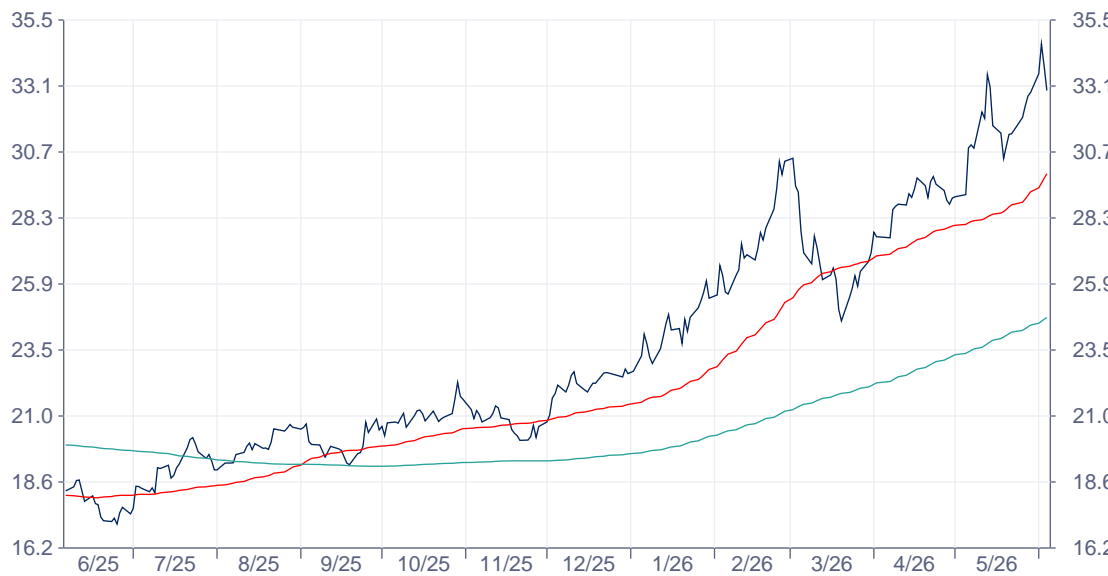

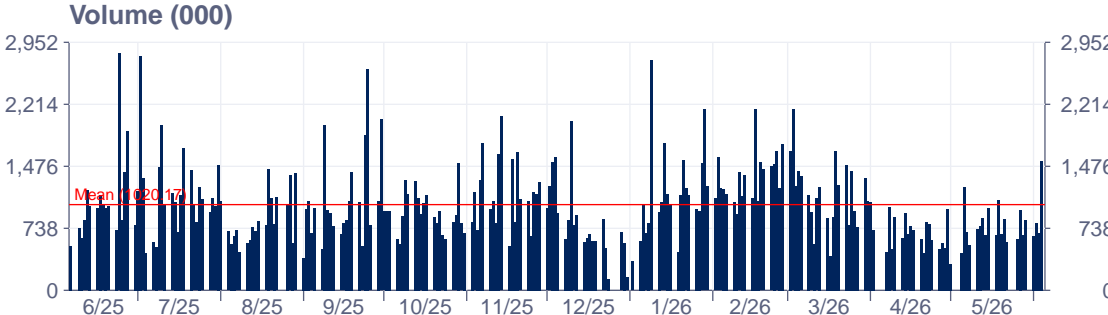
Price, Moving Averages & Volume



BHP Group Ltd is currently trading at 32.95 which is 10.2% above its 50 day moving average price of 29.91 and 33.7% above its 200 day moving average price of 24.64.

BHP:LN is currently 4.9% below its 52-week high price of 34.65 and is 92.9% above its 52-week low price of 17.09. Over the past 52-weeks, BHP:LN is up 78.5% while on a calendar year-to-date basis it is up 45.9%.

The Relative Strength Index (RSI) indicator for BHP:LN is currently 58.55. An RSI value of 70 and above is considered overbought and 30 and below oversold.



— Price — Price (50-Day Simple Moving Average) — Price (200-Day Simple Moving Average)

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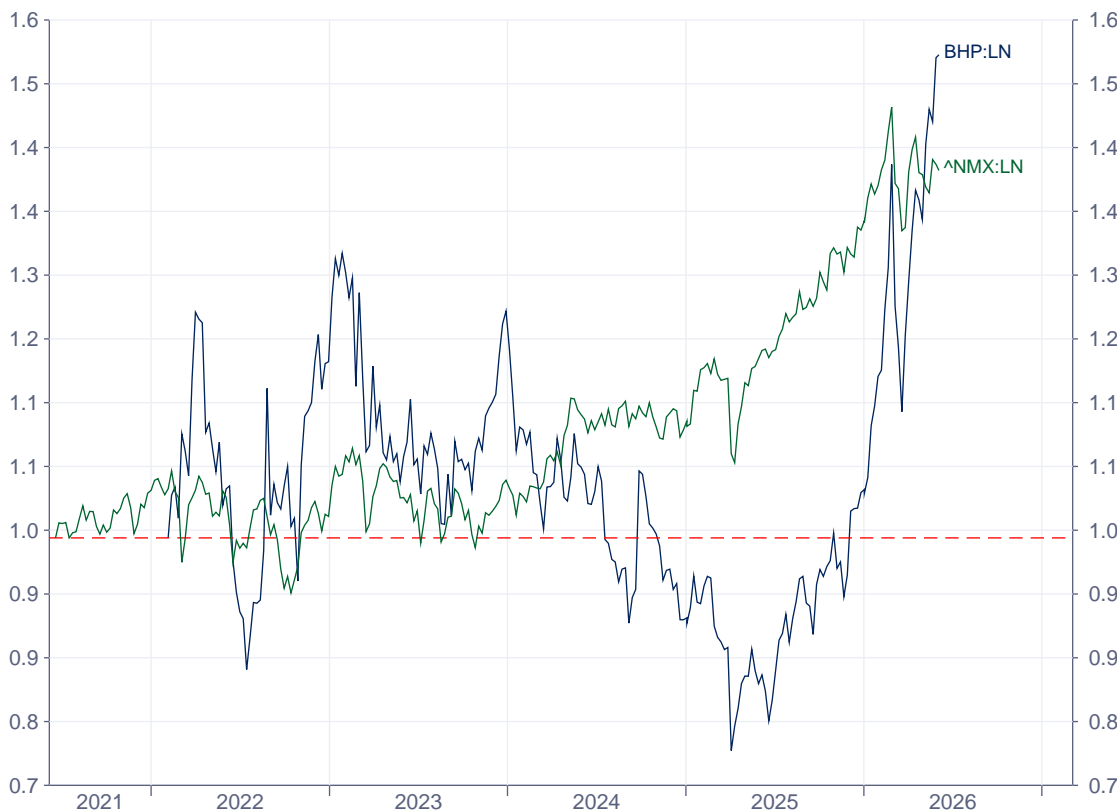

Over the past five years, BHP Group Ltd's stock price is up 53.0% which is 12.7% above the FTSE 350 Index performance of 40.3% over the same period. BHP Group Ltd's cumulative annualized growth rate (CAGR) over the five year period has been 10.3% while that of the FTSE 350 Index has been 7.1%.

Over the past year, BHP Group Ltd's stock price performance of 78.5% has outperformed that of the FTSE 350 Index by 61.7%. On a year-to-date basis, BHP Group Ltd's stock price performance of 45.9% has outperformed the FTSE 350 Index by 41.6%.

Over the past week, BHP Group Ltd's stock price performance of 0.6% has outperformed that of the FTSE 350 Index by 1.2%.

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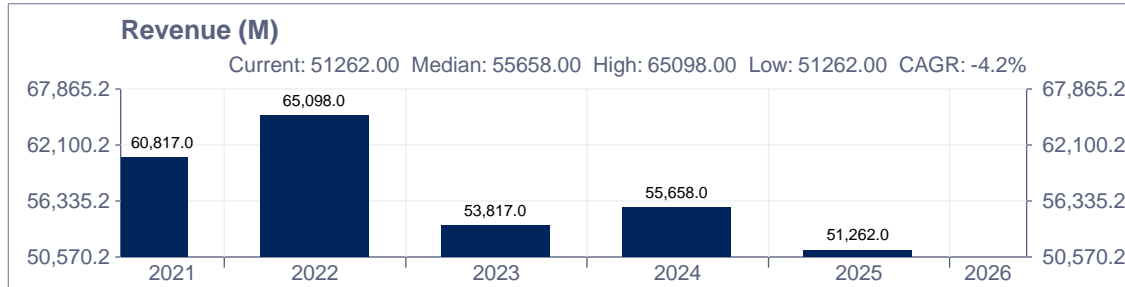
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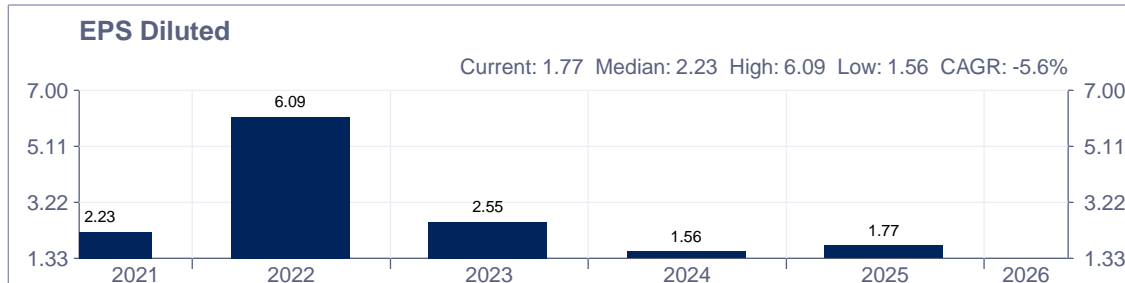

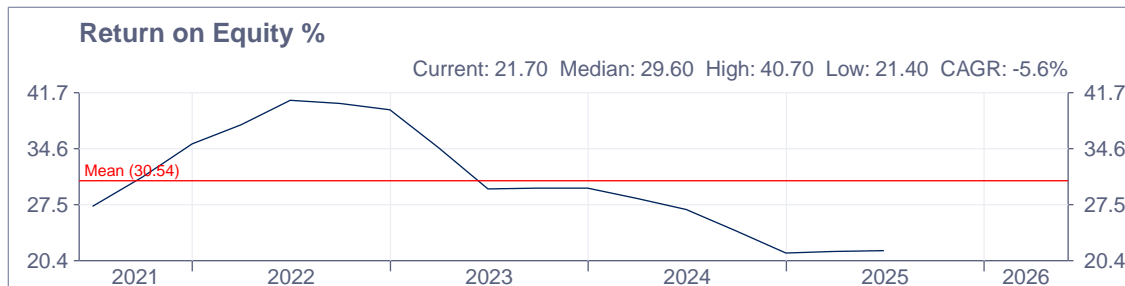
BHP Group Ltd's cumulative annualized revenue growth rate over the charted period is -4.2%. This compares to cumulative annualized growth of -3.6% over the past 3 years.



BHP Group Ltd's cumulative annualized EPS growth rate over the charted period is -5.6%. This compares to cumulative annualized growth of -15.2% over the past 3 years.



BHP Group Ltd's net profit margin of 19.7% is 4.5% below the period's mean net margin of 24.2%. During the charted period, the observed net profit margin high and low were 29.7% and 18.1% respectively.



BHP Group Ltd's return on equity of 21.7% is 8.8% below the period's mean return on equity of 30.5%. During the charted period, the observed ROE high and low were 40.7% and 21.4% respectively.

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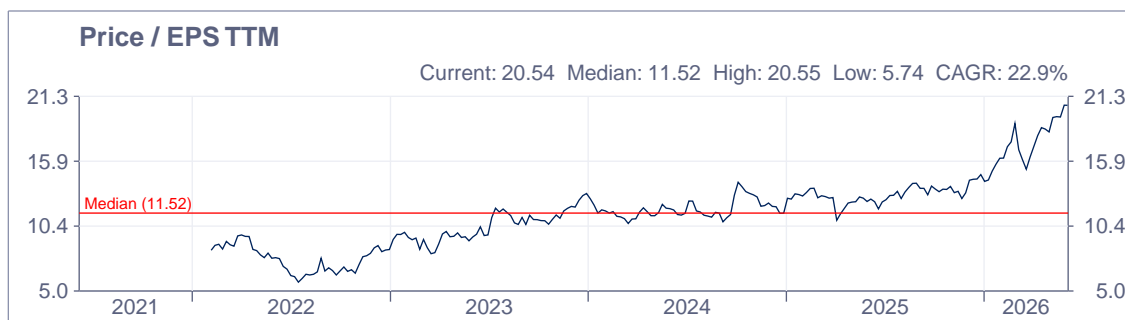
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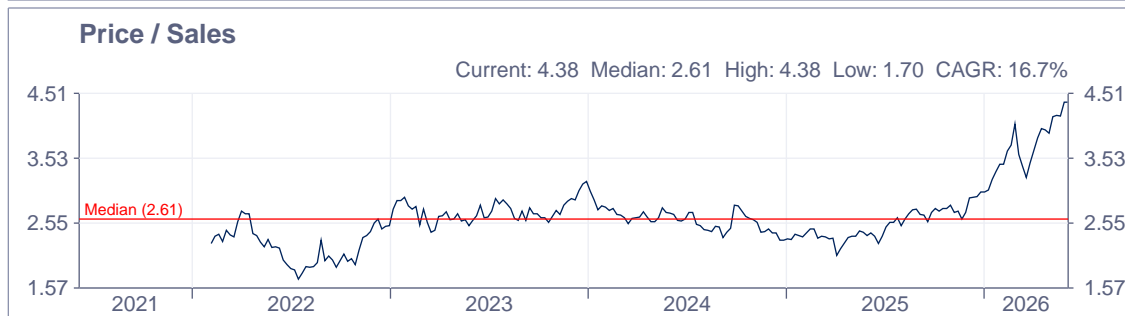

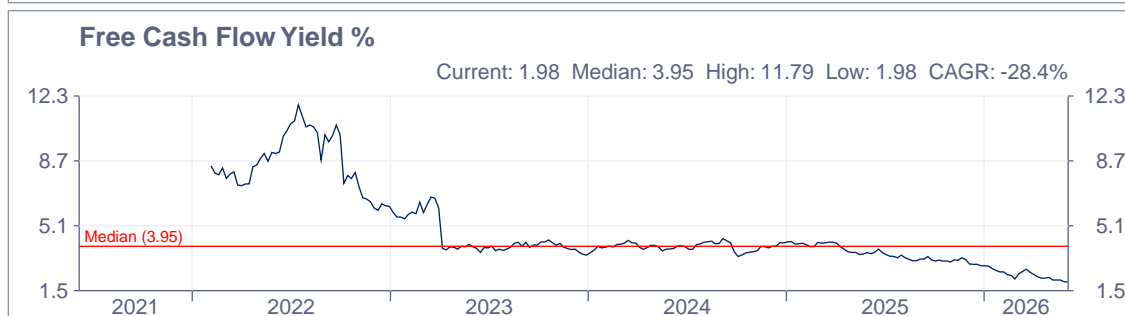
BHP Group Ltd is trading at 20.54 times its EPS generated during the latest fiscal year. This multiple is above the historically observed median of 11.52, while high and low observations have been 20.55 and 5.74.



BHP Group Ltd is trading at a Price to Sales ratio of 4.38 based on sales generated during the latest fiscal year. This ratio is above the historically observed median ratio of 2.61, while high and low observations have been 4.38 and 1.70.



BHP Group Ltd is trading at a Price to Book ratio of 4.71 based on book value at the latest fiscal year end. This ratio is above the historically observed median of 3.23, while high and low observations have been 4.71 and 2.30.



BHP Group Ltd has a Free Cash Flow Yield of 1.98% based on free cash flow generated during the latest fiscal year. This value is below the historically observed median yield of 3.95%, while high and low observations have been 11.79 and 1.98.

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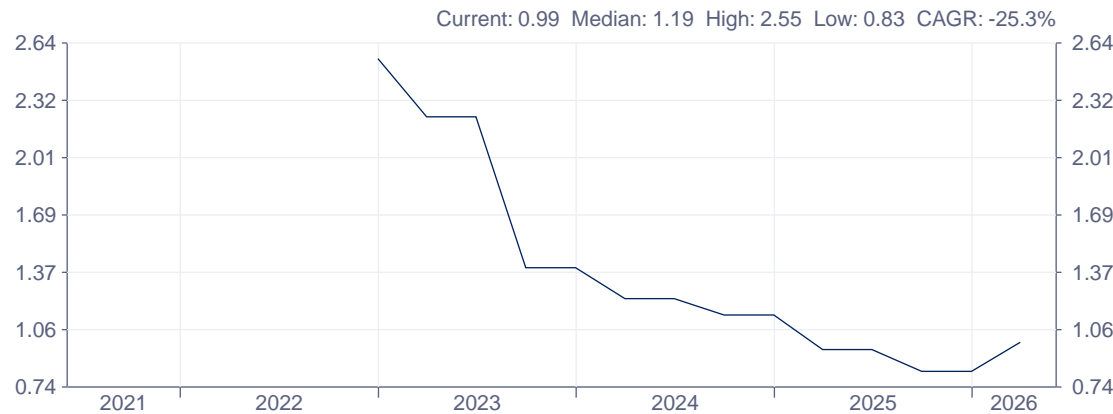

BHP Group Ltd's trailing 12-month dividend per share is 0.99 and its dividend has grown at a cumulative annualized rate of -25.3% over the charted period. This compares to dividend growth of 3.90% over the past year and cumulative annualized growth of -23.70% over the past 3 years.

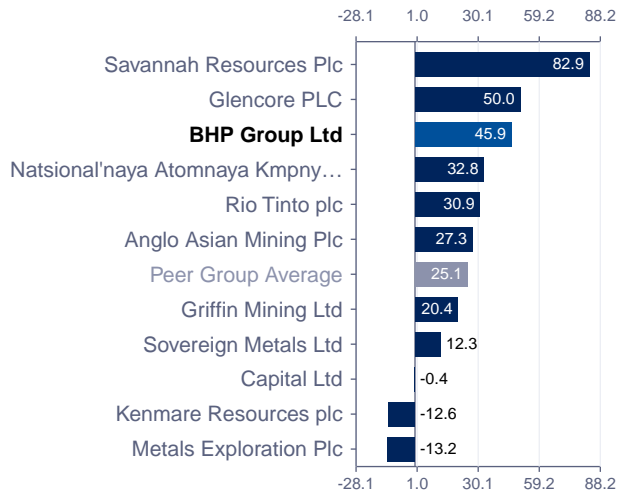
Dividend Yield TTM %



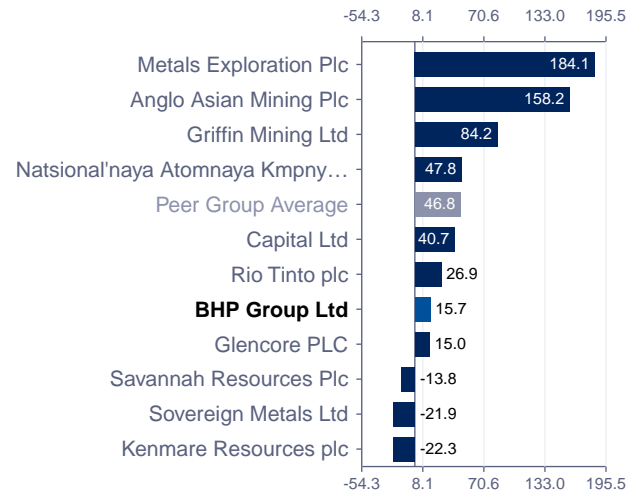

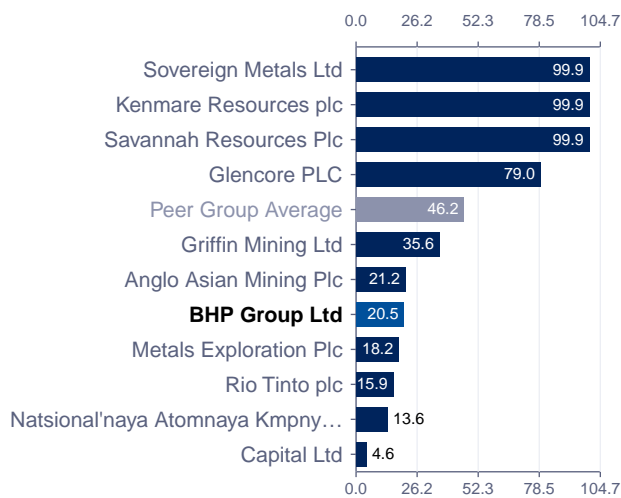
Price Change Year to Date %



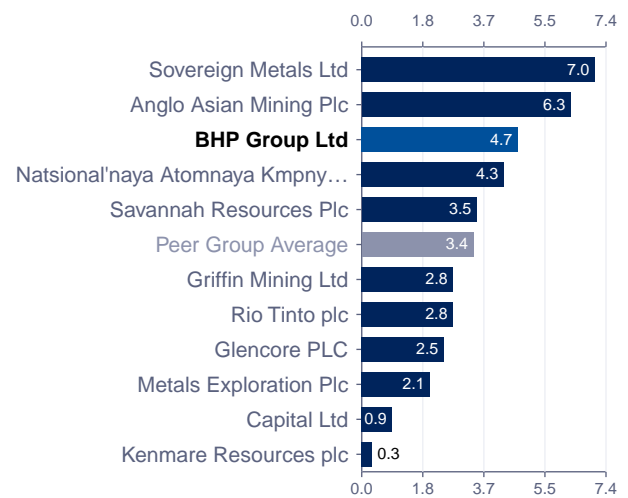
Price Change Last Calendar Year %



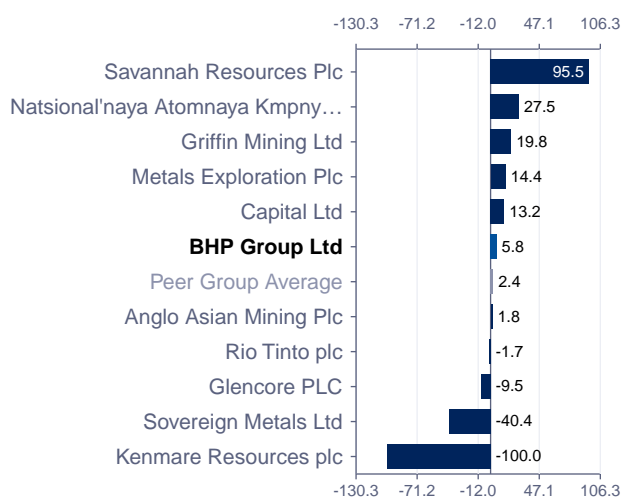
Price / EPS TTM



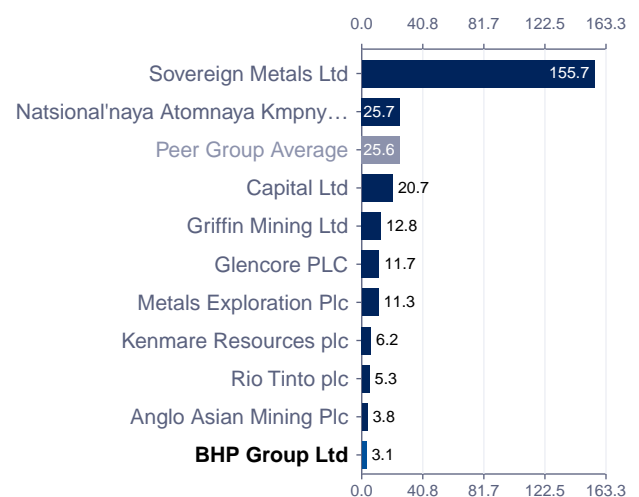
Price / Book Value

Definitions:

Market Value - Weekly Price times latest Shares Outstanding times any applicable ADR factor.

Revenue - Sum of the last four quarters of Revenues.

Revenue Per Share - Sum of the last four quarters of Total Revenue divided by Weighted Average Shares Outstanding.

Normalized EPS LFY- EPS excluding non-recurring, non-operating items, fiscal year aligned TTM value.

60-Day Average Volume (000) - The average of the last 60 daily volume values in thousands of shares.

Price 52-Week High - The high closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price 52-Week Low - The low closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price / 52-Week High - Latest price divided by the high price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

Price / 52-Week Low - Latest price divided by the low price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.

50-Day Average Price - Mean of last 50 daily closing prices.

200-Day Average Price - Mean of last 200 daily closing prices.

Price / 50-Day Average Price - Latest closing price divided by mean of last 50 daily closing prices, as a percentage.

Price / 200-Day Average Price - Latest closing price divided by mean of last 200 daily closing prices, as a percentage.

Relative Strength Index - Relative Strength Index or RSI measures the magnitude of gains over a given time period against the magnitude of losses over that period. The equation is $RSI = 100 - 100 / (1 + RS)$ where $RS = (\text{total gains} / n) / (\text{total losses} / n)$ and $n = \text{number of RSI periods}$. In this item, 14 days is used and one year of daily prices are considered. A value of 30 or below may imply oversold and 70 or above may imply overbought.

Price Volatility - The standard deviation of the last 20 days of daily closing prices.

Sharpe Ratio - The 5 year average of the excess monthly return over the risk - free rate(1 - month T - bill) over the 5 year standard deviation of the same series.

Sortino Ratio - The same calculation as the Sharpe Ratio but with positive excess returns set to zero for the standard deviation denominator, so only negative volatility weighs in.

Dividends Per Share TTM - Sum of the last four quarters of Dividends Per Share.

Payout Ratio - Dividends Per Share TTM divided by Normalized EPS TTM.

Dividend Yield TTM % - Sum of the last four quarter of Dividends Per Share divided by Weekly Price.

EBITDA - Sum of the last four quarters of EBITDA (Operating Income + Depreciation & Amortization).

Free Cash Flow - Sum of the last four quarters Net Cash from Operations minus Capital Expenditures (Purchase of Property, Plant & Equipment), from the Cash Flow Statement.

Book Value Per Share - Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter.

Gross Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters Gross Profit divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

EBITDA Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters EBITDA divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

Pre-Tax Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters of Earnings Before Taxes divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues.

Net Profit Margin % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues Per Share.

Return on Equity % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Book Value.

Return on Capital % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Capital Per Share.

Return on Assets % - Sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Assets Per Share.

Price / EPS TTM - Weekly Price divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Normalized EPS (capped at 99.9).

Price / Sales - Weekly Price divided by Revenues Per Share TTM.

Price / Book Value - Weekly Price divided by Book Value Per Share last quarter. Book Value Per Share is Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter (capped at 49.9).

Free Cash Flow Yield % - Free Cash Flow Per Share TTM divided by Weekly Price.

Enterprise Value - Market Value plus Total Debt last year plus Preferred Equity last year minus Cash & Cash Equivalents last year.

Enterprise Value / Sales - Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Revenue.

Enterprise Value / EBITDA - Enterprise Value divided by EBITDA TTM.

Enterprise Value / EBIT - Enterprise Value divided by trailing four quarters of Operating Income.

Enterprise Value / Free Cash Flow- Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Free Cash Flow.

Russell 1000 Index - The largest 1,000 stocks by market cap, the index comprehensively covers the US large cap universe.

EPS 5-Year Growth Rate % is capped at 999.9%.
