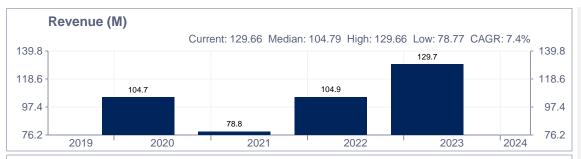




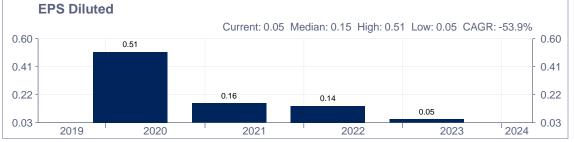

Cropper (James) PLC's trailing 12-month dividend per share is 0.07 and its dividend has grown at a cumulative annualized rate of -13.6% over the charted period. This compares to dividend growth of -26.30% over the past year and cumulative annualized growth of % over the past 3 years.
