Ironveld PLC is currently trading at 0.10 which is 28.6% below its 50 day moving average price of 0.14 and 54.5% below its 200 day moving average price of 0.22.

IRON:LN is currently 73.0% below its 52-week high price of 0.37 and is 11.1% above its 52-week low price of 0.09. Over the past 52-weeks, IRON:LN is down 72.9% while on a calendar year-to-date basis it is down 44.3%.

The Relative Strength Index (RSI) indicator for IRON:LN is currently 24.94. An RSI value of 70 and above is considered overbought and 30 and below oversold.

Over the past year, Ironveld PLC's stock price performance of -72.9% has underperformed that of the FTSE 350 Index by 74.4%. On a year-to-date basis, Ironveld PLC's stock price performance of -44.3% has underperformed the FTSE 350 Index by 47.5%.

<b>Market Value</b>	- Weekly Price times latest Shares Outstanding times any applicable ADR factor.
<b>Revenue</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Revenues.
<b>Revenue Per Share</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Total Revenue divided by Weighted Average Shares Outstanding.
<b>Operating EPS LFY</b>	- EPS excluding non-recurring, non-operating items, fiscal year aligned TTM value.
<b>60-Day Average Volume (000)</b>	- The average of the last 60 daily volume values in thousands of shares.
<b>Price 52-Week High</b>	- The high closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.
<b>Price 52-Week Low</b>	- The low closing price from the last 52 weeks of daily closing prices.
<b>Price / 52-Week High</b>	- Latest price divided by the high price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.
<b>Price / 52-Week Low</b>	- Latest price divided by the low price from the past 52 weeks of daily closing prices.
<b>50-Day Average Price</b>	- Mean of last 50 daily closing prices.
<b>200-Day Average Price</b>	- Mean of last 200 daily closing prices.
<b>Price / 50-Day Average Price</b>	- Latest closing price divided by mean of last 50 daily closing prices, as a percentage.
<b>Price / 200-Day Average Price</b>	- Latest closing price divided by mean of last 200 daily closing prices, as a percentage.
<b>Relative Strength Index</b>	- Relative Strength Index or RSI measures the magnitude of gains over a given time period against the magnitude of losses over that period. The equation is $RSI = 100 - 100 / (1 + RS)$ where $RS = (total\ gains / n) / (total\ losses / n)$ and $n =$ number of RSI periods. In this item, 14 days is used and one year of daily prices are considered. A value of 30 or below may imply oversold and 70 or above may imply overbought.
<b>Price Volatility</b>	- The standard deviation of the last 20 days of daily closing prices.
<b>Sharpe Ratio</b>	- The 5 year average of the excess monthly return over the risk - free rate(1 - month T - bill) over the 5 year standard deviation of the same series.
<b>Sortino Ratio</b>	- The same calculation as the Sharpe Ratio but with positive excess returns set to zero for the standard deviation denominator, so only negative volatility weighs in.
<b>Dividends Per Share TTM</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Dividends Per Share.
<b>Payout Ratio</b>	- Dividends Per Share TTM divided by Operating EPS TTM.
<b>Dividend Yield TTM %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarter of Dividends Per Share divided by Weekly Price.
<b>EBITDA</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of EBITDA (Operating Income + Depreciation & Amortization).
<b>Free Cash Flow</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters Net Cash from Operations minus Capital Expenditures (Purchase of Property, Plant & Equipment), from the Cash Flow Statement.
<b>Book Value Per Share</b>	- Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter.
<b>Gross Margin %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters Gross Profit divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.
<b>EBITDA Margin %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters EBITDA divided by the sum of the last four quarters Revenues.
<b>Pre-Tax Margin %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Earnings Before Taxes divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues.
<b>Net Profit Margin %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Operating EPS divided by sum of the last four quarters Revenues Per Share.
<b>Return on Equity %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Operating EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Book Value.
<b>Return on Capital %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Operating EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Capital Per Share.
<b>Return on Assets %</b>	- Sum of the last four quarters of Operating EPS divided by the average of the last four quarters Total Assets Per Share.
<b>Price / EPS TTM</b>	- Weekly Price divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Operating EPS (capped at 99.9).
<b>Price / Sales</b>	- Weekly Price divided by Revenues Per Share TTM.
<b>Price / Book Value</b>	- Weekly Price divided by Book Value Per Share last quarter. Book Value Per Share is Total Common Equity last quarter divided by Shares Outstanding last quarter (capped at 49.9).
<b>Free Cash Flow Yield %</b>	- Free Cash Flow Per Share TTM divided by Weekly Price.
<b>Enterprise Value</b>	- Market Value plus Total Debt last year plus Preferred Equity last year minus Cash & Cash Equivalents last year.
<b>Enterprise Value / Sales</b>	- Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Revenue.
<b>Enterprise Value / EBITDA</b>	- Enterprise Value divided by EBITDA TTM.
<b>Enterprise Value / EBIT</b>	- Enterprise Value divided by trailing four quarters of Operating Income.
<b>Enterprise Value / Free Cash Flow</b>	- Enterprise Value divided by the sum of the last four quarters of Free Cash Flow.
<b>Russell 1000 Index</b>	- The largest 1,000 stocks by market cap, the index comprehensively covers the US large cap universe.
<b>EPS 5-Year Growth Rate %</b>	is capped at 999.9%.
<b>Revenue 5-Year Growth Rate %</b>	is capped at 999.9%.

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
